

The Salvage Sounds Pencil Case Strumstick Christmas Songbook

HOW TO USE THIS GUIDE

Welcome to playing music by numbers! Playing the Salvage Sounds pencil case strumstick is about as easy as it gets. There are only three strings, and just seven notes on each. Yet with such a simple instrument we are able to play many, many popular tunes and songs as you will soon find out.

In order to follow the music presented on the pages that follow, think of the neck of the instrument as below with each note being represented by a number placed on one of three lines – one for each string:



To the left are the tuning pegs, and to the right is the pencil case body. The bottom of these strings is tuned to a low G. The top string is tuned to a high G. The middle string is tuned to a D, between the two.

The numbers show where to press the pad of the fingertip (applying pressure behind the metal fret). A zero means plucking the string by itself (or “open” as it is known) with no action required with the fretting hand.

As such the following sequence of string presses (with whichever finger feels most comfortable and natural) would be represented by the accompanying tablature - or “tab” as it is more commonly called:

There is more information about our pencil case strumstick on our website (salvagesounds.co.uk) including a separate short guide, which refers to more advanced playing techniques such as use of chords. The most basic of these “advanced” methods is simply to turn your single string plucks into a full rhythmic strum that spans the entire set of strings. In this way, every position on the neck can be turned into a full chord and provide additional depth and interest to the sound. Try both plucking and strumming with the following pieces of music to get a feel of what sounds best – and more importantly, what you have the most fun doing!
